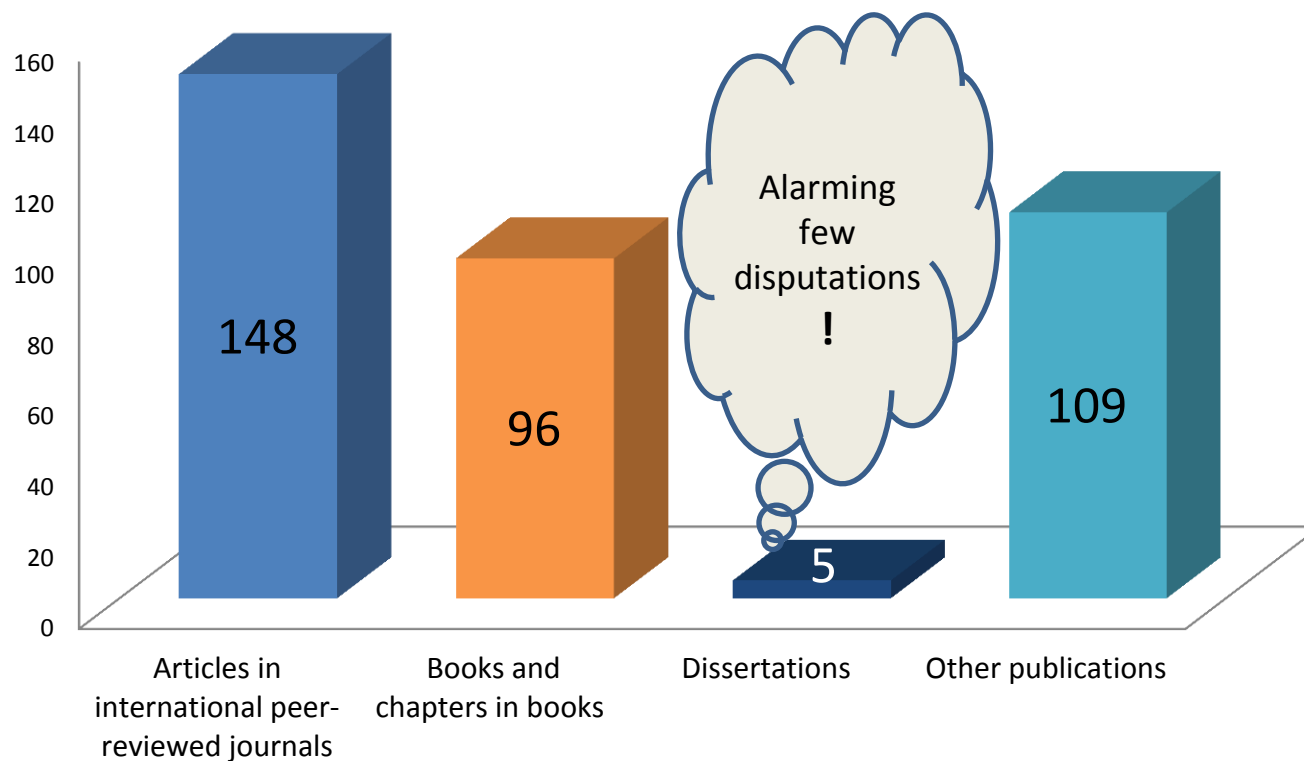

# Scientific publications 2000—2012 by members of the Swedish Psychoanalytic Association

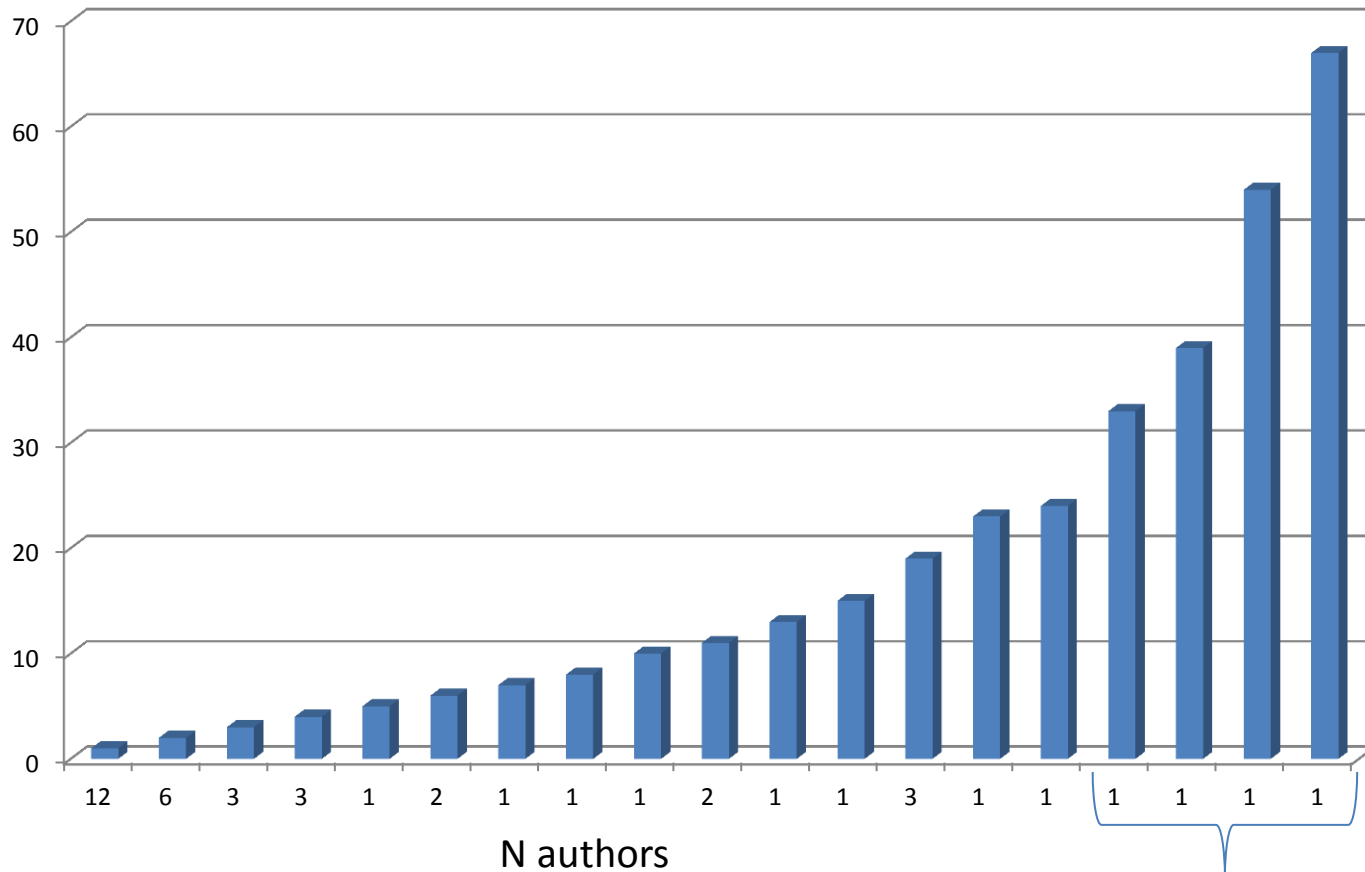


# 358 publications by 43 authors and co-authors

N publications

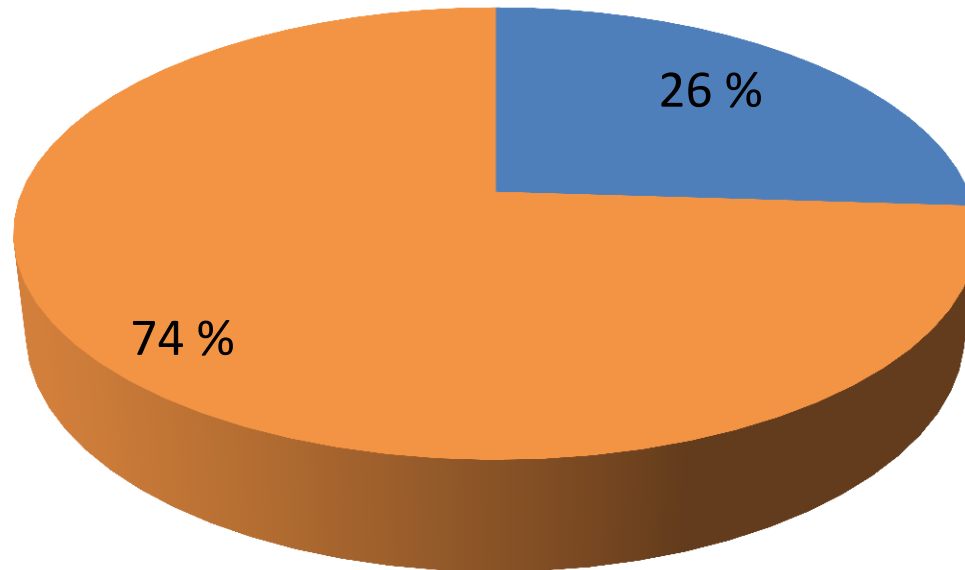

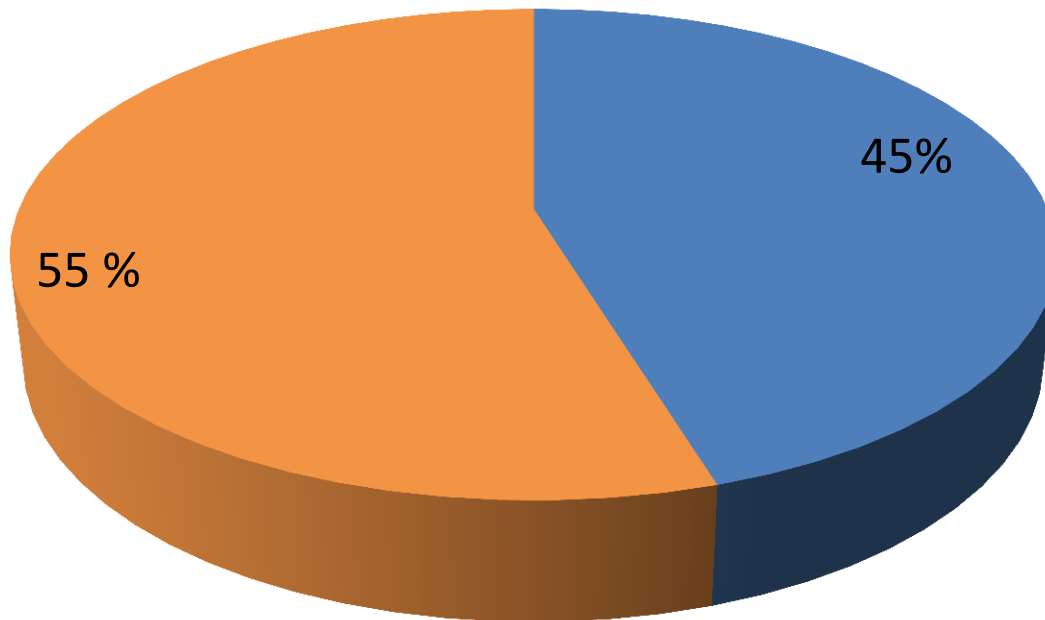

- 81 articles in other journals

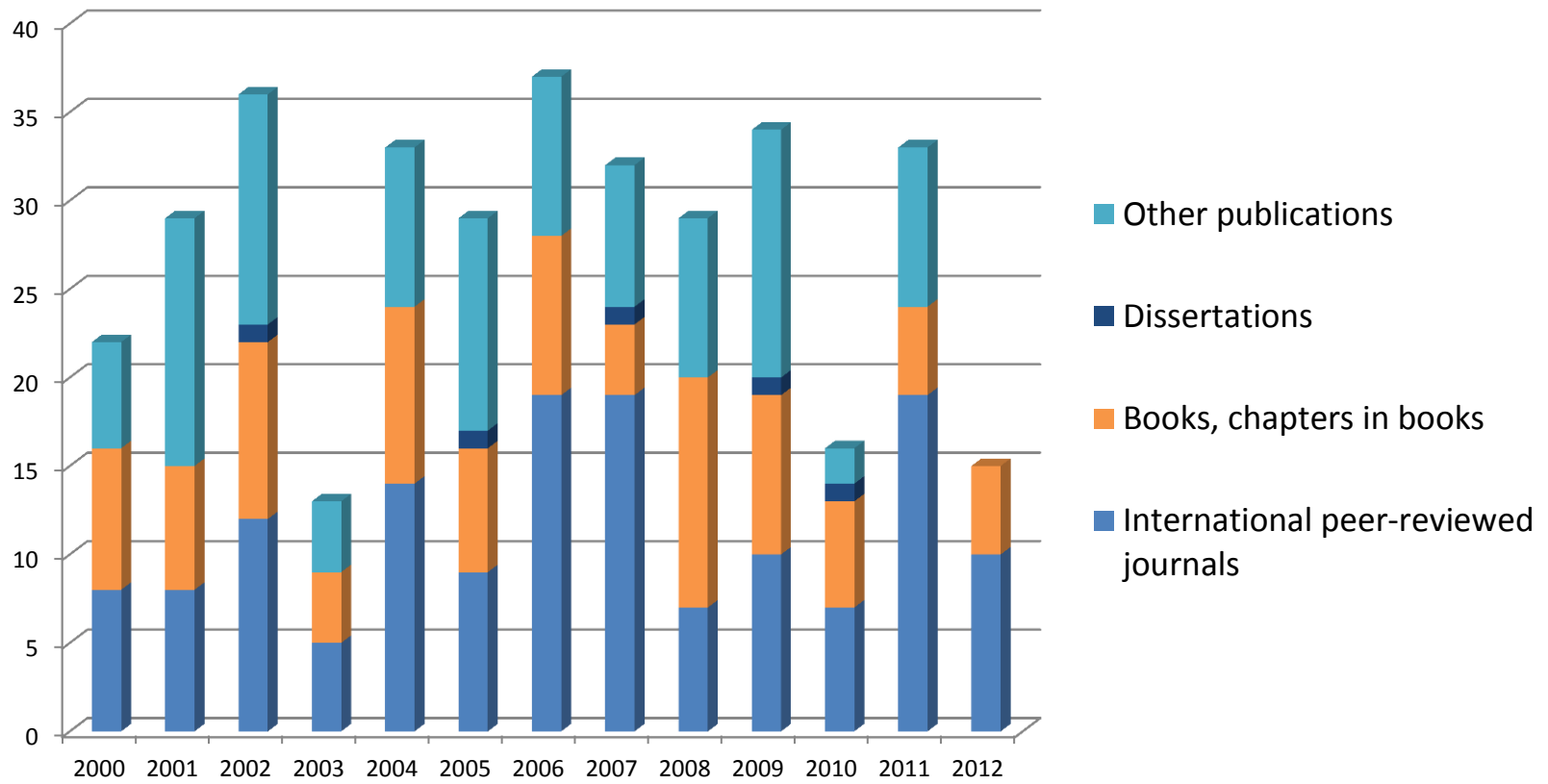

# Empirical psychoanalytic and psychodynamic studies 2000—2012

- 58 studies identified
  - from minor qualitative studies to major long-term investigations
  - from one-man studies to large international research teams
- 31 of these studies were conducted by psychoanalysts (53%)
- However, of the in total 124 researchers involved, only 15 are members of the Swedish Psychoanalytic Association (12%)
